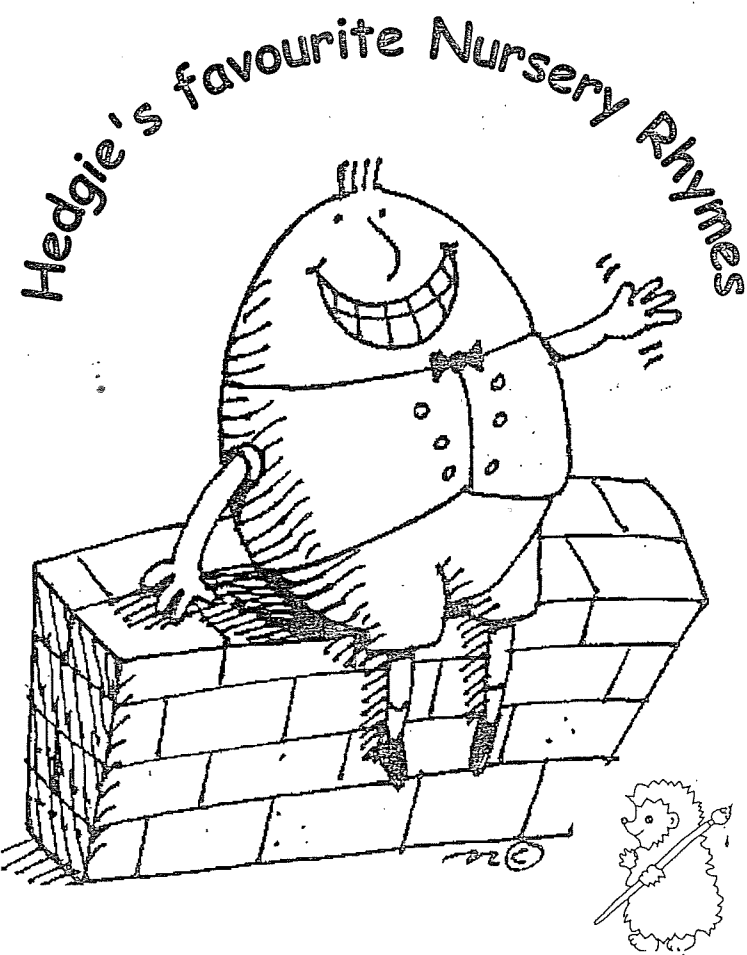
Humpty Dumpty

Couldn't put Humpty together again.



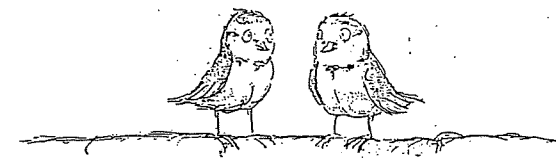
Baa, Baa, Black Sheep

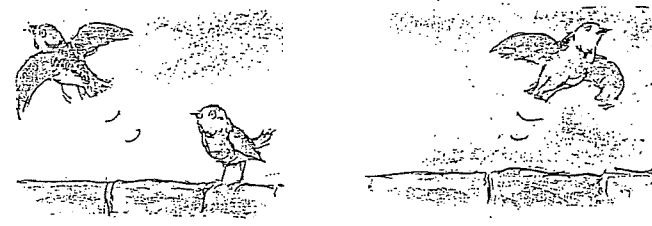

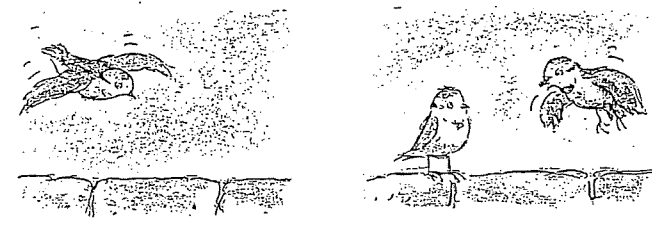
Two Little Dickie Birds
